



RED HOT Series Travel Grants

Purpose

The RED HOT (Research Education Development for Healthcare Professionals in Organ Transplantation) Series aims to support trainees in developing the essential skills for successful research careers in donation and transplantation. This initiative is designed to prepare healthcare professionals in organ transplantation for research-focused careers through principles of education, practice, and collaboration.

With funding from a CIHR Planning and Dissemination Grant, the Canadian Society of Transplantation (CST) will provide travel grants for eligible trainees to attend both the CST Fellows Symposium and the CST Annual Scientific Meeting (ASM), taking place October 6-10, 2025, in Vancouver, BC.

Eligibility Criteria

Applicants must meet the following requirements:

1. **CST Membership:** Must be a CST member enrolled in a Canadian solid organ transplant training program.
2. **Event Attendance:** Must attend both the CST Fellows Symposium.
3. **Workshop Participation:** Must attend the RED HOT webinar series workshop.
4. **Workshop Report:** Must submit a RED HOT webinar series workshop report summarizing key learnings and how they will apply this knowledge in their research or clinical practice by October 15th, 2025.
5. **Demonstrated Engagement:** Preference will be given to trainees who have actively participated in previous RED HOT webinar series sessions.

Funding Details

- Each successful applicant will receive a minimum of \$500. The final grant amount will be determined based on available funding and the number of successful applicants.
- The grant will be paid after the workshop report has been submitted.
