





### Number of Wait-Listed Transplant Candidates by Organ Type, 2007–2016, Canada (preliminary)










## Number of Canadian Organ Donors by Donor Source, 2007–2016, Canada (preliminary)




## Deceased Donor Rate (PMP) by Year, 2007–2016, Canada (preliminary)









### Proportion of deceased donors, by age, 2007-2016, Canada






## Proportion of DCD among all deceased donors, 2007-2016, Canada







### Donor Rate (PMP) by Donor Source (Deceased vs. Living), 2007–2016, Canada (preliminary)








# Living Donor Rate (PMP) by Region, 2007–2016, Canada (preliminary)



### Proportion of living donors by relation, 2007-2016, Canada











## Number of Organ Transplants by Donor Source, 2007–2016, Canada (preliminary)



#### Transplant Rate (PMP), by organ




## Number of Kidney Transplants by Donor Type, Adult (18+), 2006 to 2017 (preliminary)




# Number of Kidney Transplants by Centre, All Ages, 2016 (preliminary)






## Proportion of Kidney Transplants from Deceased vs. Living Donors, by Centre, All Ages, 2016 (preliminary)






#### Kidney Transplant Rate (PMP), 2015, by country




#### Liver Transplant Rate (PMP), 2015, by country



#### Summary

- The number of wait-listed patients outnumber the number transplant recipients
- Significant rise in deceased donation in Canada in recent years 

   increased transplantation rates in Canada
- Living donor (kidney) transplantation is declining despite new initiatives
- Canadian rates of donation and transplantation are lower than the US, but outcomes are better
- Regional variability in deceased and living donor transplantation indicate room for growth

#### Areas in Development

- National collaboration and oversight
- Ongoing need for more granular and standardized provincial and national data
- Minimizing regional variability in practice
- Innovation in policy and research to expand access to and outcomes after transplantation
