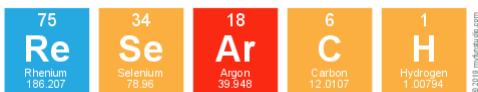
TRAVEL BURSARY ANNOUNCEMENT



On-going initiatives have been made by the CST to encourage the involvement of Allied Health members. The intent of the Pediatric Group Allied Health Travel Bursary is to help facilitate the attendance of Pediatric Allied Health Professionals at the Annual CST Pediatric Group Annual Dinner and Business Meeting at the 2019 Canadian Transplant Summit in Banff, who might not otherwise have the opportunity or resources to attend.
